



- Always support the weight of the luminaire.



CEILING CUT-OUT OPENING 12 3/4" x 48 1/2"








Note:

Due to possible uneven ceiling surfaces, some light leaks may appear at the flange/ceiling junction. It may be necessary to manually bend the end trims to suit.



NOTE: For use in Cleanroom Spaces

1. Sealing the Flange Kit:

Seal the perimeter of the flange kit adjacent to the surface and any other visible seams using site approved sealant (by others). Sealing should be applied in a manner that prevents the ingress of dust, debris and any airborne contaminant particles.
