NOTES

- Installation should be completed by an individual familiar with the construction and operation of the luminaire.
- Installation of luminaire must be in accordance with nation and local building and electrical codes.

This product complies with this requirement since the installation instruction requires installation in restricted access area.
- Do not mount the luminaire to ceiling if convenience outlet option is provided

WARNINGS

Electric shock:

- Use correctly rated supply conductors as indicated by product labeling.


Burn:

Allow luminaire to cool before handling luminaire.


Personal Injury:

Mounting hardware (4) - by others. Two (2) required on each side of mounting offsets. Min fastener length: 11/2"



- 1. Carefully remove luminaire from packaging.
- 2. Remove end caps on standard unit, for C58 option this step is not required.
- 3. Remove lens from luminaire.
- 4. Remove wire way cover from luminaire.
- 5. Determine the location of the junction box and remove the corresponding K.O. on the naire and install any strain relief connector (by others) as required by local electrical codes.
- 6. Pull electrical supply wires through the knockout hole and into the luminaire.
- 7. Mount the luminaire to the mounting surface (ceiling/wall) using wood screws or priate hardware (by others). If no joists are present, use toggle bolts (by others).
- 8. Make the necessary wiring connections and ground connections in accordance with local electrical and /or building codes.
- 9. Re-install wire way cover.
- 10. Re-install lens for standard unit (for the C58 option, end plates are not required to be re-installed).
